# Mark's Thoughts

## A New Government of Love

When Jesus declared that the Kingdom of Heaven had come near one of the things Jesus did was inaugurate a 'new government of love', the way of heaven, the way of grace, the way of love. It's a heart to heart thing.

## In this new government of love people, us included, are 'free'

it is a way of living, a culture, a culture of honour

where other people don't control who you/we are

where other people cannot remove your/our freedom.

Where "Perfect loves cast out fear" 1 John4:18

Where there is no intimidation, that is, 'no intent to make one timid'.

Instead the intent is to agree with the Spirit,

who fills you with love power and a sound mind. (1 Tim 2:7)

Where, like Jesus, we are not concerned with another persons

identity as the world would describe it. Rather,

we are concerned with their identity as 'a son or daughter of God',

even if as yet they have not acknowledged their new identity.

Let us get things the right way around ....

God is clear about our identity as his sons and daughters even if at times we are not so sure. God wants to do a work in us so that we might be the brightest light the saltiest salt, the most powerful beacon of hope, the best testimony ever written about Jesus transforming power.

## In this new government of love the best in us shows up everywhere we go!

The best in us shows up everywhere we go even when the best in others doesn't show up around us. Even when we are not so sure about other peoples identity either particularly when they hurt us when they - exclude us - put us down - tell us off or gossip about us or or or!! A culture of honour isn't just a 'values statement' that looks good on a website

It's something that has to be lived. You'll know if someone around you

is living out this culture because you will not be living in fear and they will be constantly drawing out the gold in you. And because they draw out the best in you, you won't be offended when they call your attention to the dirt on your life.

When we trust our lives with one another, and pour out our lives, pour out our strength into one another we live in the 'new government of love' we create a living culture, true koinonia - true fellowship.

It is not a culture that you can force another to take up and live out. It is not a culture or way to live that you can be forced to live. The nature and character of God, the creational foundations God laid are built on 'freedom', where we are free to choose. We have always been free. Jesus freely chose this way of life, he modelled for us. It is not easy, there is no "app' for it. Life doesn't get easier but it gets better especially for the lives of those to whom we are connected and influence.
