An Urgent Appeal to Help a Struggling Congregation in Transylvania

Winter is coming!!

The Reformed Church of Transylvania in Romania congregation, located in Săcele, east of Brasov has a small and a big problem.

The small congregation of about 40 worshipping committed Christians who struggled through the Covid pandemic with many deaths amongst their numbers resulting in greatly reduced income, are now being faced with gas prices caused by the war in the Ukraine increasing more than 5 fold in the past few months.

The inefficient and antiquated heating system in the church manse is no longer able to be used as the cost of heating is expected to be more than the congregational giving.

To avert a freezing winter the congregation is urgently needing to upgrade the heating system to a modern efficient system which will cut their costs dramatically.

While they have raised a good amount of money, in order to finish this installation they require a further \$7,500AUD. In order to raise this the congregation is considering securing a loan which will take them more than 5 years to pay off and add to their current plight.

For us, in Australia, this is a relatively small amount.

But, for Romania, this is a cost that is way beyond their reach.

This is not an appeal from Rev Mark, but a response to a need that I believe we can do something practically and urgently for a congregation that has been devastated by Covid and is now caught in both the Ukrainian refugee crisis and energy prices that are doubling every single month.

This is an extremely poor community and we can do a little in order for them to receive much.

Mental health and well-being are in the spotlight this week through <u>R U OK Day</u> and <u>World Suicide Prevention Day</u>.

The message behind R U OK Day, which is on Thursday, September 8, is to encourage anyone struggling with things happening in their lives to chat with a friend or reach out to a service, such as Lifeline. Chris Ikin is the Office of the Synod's Health and Wellness Coordinator, and he said R U OK Day is very relevant to the church.

"We want to help people and provide resources that can be easily accessed," he said.

"We've got the Sickness and Accident Assistance Plan (SAAP) for Ministers, the wellness hub, and Benestar for Synod employees and Ministry agents."

Free COVID-19 RAT kits

From August 2022, you can get free Rapid Antigen Tests (RATs) at Queensland Health RAT distribution points if you:

- hold an eligible Commonwealth Concession card
- are at risk of or experiencing homelessness, including people escaping domestic and family violence
- are seeking <u>asylum</u> in Queensland
- recently arrived from <u>Ukraine</u>
- working in Queensland as part of the <u>Pacific Australia Labour Mobility scheme</u>.
