


Presbytery Secretary

From The Word for Today...

Use your God-given creativity

'He has filled them with skill to do all manner of work.' Exodus 35:35 NKJV

The Bible says God 'filled them with skill to do all manner of work of the engraver and the designer and the tapestry maker, in blue, purple, and scarlet thread, and fine linen, and of the weaver – those who do every work and those who design artistic works' (Exodus 35:35 NKJV).

When God calls you to do something, He has already placed within you the ability to accomplish it. Satan hopes you never discover that. He wants you to remain trapped in the status quo, believing that the way things *are* is how they will *always* be. Not so! When you change your thinking, your life begins to change. '*For as he thinks in his heart, so is he'* (Proverbs 23:7 NKJV). As long as you are content to remain as you are, you will never begin to think creatively. But when you decide you want your life to change for the better, you become teachable and open yourself to becoming creative. Like anything else in life, creativity begins with one idea.
