Nothing about you surprises God

'For He chose us in Him, before the foundation of the world, to be holy and blameless in love before Him.' Ephesians 1:4 CSB

Nothing about you surprises God. He knew what He was getting when He chose you. He 'actually chose us out for Himself as His own'. You didn't just randomly show up one day. And God hasn't decided to merely tolerate you. He is not rolling His eyes when you have a problem. Instead, He will always remind you how far you have come, how well you are doing, how precious you are in His sight, and how much He loves you.
